

# 1st Denmark Japan Bowl®

The Japan Bowl® is the Japanese language and culture competition for students who are interested in Japanese. It was organized by the Japan-America Society of Washington DC in 1992. Since 2016, The Japan Bowls has been expanded overseas and now held in Poland, England, Italy, Mexico, Serbia, Bulgaria, France, etc. The Denmark Japan Bowl is held for the first time on 14<sup>th</sup> April 2018.

## 1. Date and Location

#### 2. Topics

The Japan Bowl questions will cover the basic knowledge from topics including: History, Arts and Culture, Social Sciences, Daily Life and Society, Popular Culture, Language.



\*All the questions will be asked in English and/or Japanese. The top three teams from the Preliminary Round will proceed to the Championship Round.

## 3. Eligibility:

- a. Students at efterskole, gymnasium, hoejskole, university, or master's degree who are interested in Japanese are eligible to compete at the
- b Students who are native speaker of Japanese or who use Japanese at home are not eligible to compete.
- c. Students who have spent a cumulative total of one year or more in Japan are not eligible to compete.
