Our knowledge of Viking Age military organization is based on a broad variety of different sources. Currently, seasonal or more permanent encampments and fortifications have moved into the focus of archaeological research. In the past few years, two research projects based at Aarhus University and Moesgard Museum, 'Aggersborg' and 'The king's fortresses' have readdressed central questions relating to the Danish circular fortresses of the Trelleborg type and provided new insights into these structures function and significance.
