THE VENUE (www.kavosbay.com)

Kavos Bay Seafront Hotel is a traditional Greek hotel. It is run by Irini & Nikos Krassas together with their three daughters Kelly, Anthula & Ioanna. It is located in the forest district outside the village of Aghia Marina on the island of Aegina. The hotel has 25 double rooms, all with exclusive sea view. The hotel offers free internet connection. All participants will stay in a double room (a free choice of single or double use). It is a true nature lover's paradise.

The Kavos Bay Hotel is not a conference hotel as you may know them from earlier experiences. The hotel is a family run hotel and the course will primarily take place on the wonderful open-air terrace.

HOW TO GET THERE

The Island of Aegina is located close to the harbour of Piraeus, Athens. The closest airport to Aegina is located in Athens. The airport named Eleftherios Venizelos, which is located about 25 kms outside of the centre of Athens in the area of Spata.

How to get from the airport to the harbor of Piraeus

Shuttle bus

Leaving the arrivals hall, you will find bus X96, which takes you straight to the Port of Piraeus. Every 15/20 minutes a bus is leaving during the day and about every half hour at night. The bus stops several times on the way. Your ferry to Aegina leaves from GATE 8. Ask the bus driver to announce GATE 8 (but stop is next to central station in Piraeus). The price of the ticket is € 3.10 (At night the price can be slightly more) and is valid for 24 hours. You may use this ticket on the bus, trolley bus or the metro. The trip will take from 60 minutes to 75 minutes depending on the traffic! At the airport you buy the ticket at the small ticket office located next to the bus stop. In Piraeus you buy the ticket also at the ticket office next to the bus stop. After you have bought the ticket you have to put it in the ticket machines in the bus to print a date on it. So have pocket money ready when you buy a ticket, they don't accept credit card!

Taxi

You can also take a taxi from the airport to Piraeus. When leaving the airport, please make use of the taxi queue next to Door 3 of the Arrivals Level. Taking a taxi is mostly quicker than the bus (of course dependent on the traffic). Some drivers do the ride in 30 minutes! The price will be about € 30 - € 35-. The starting price with toll fee is between € 0.75 and € 2.94. At night the charge is higher.

Metro

You can take the metro from the airport to Omonia station and change to the train bound for Piraeus. The trip takes about 90 minutes and is slightly more expensive than the bus.

How to get from the harbour of Piraeus to Aegina island

To Aghia Marina (on the east side of the island, where Kavos Bay Seafront Hotel is located).

The Fast Boat named Alexandros is connecting Piraeus with Aghia Marina. Kavos Bay Seafront Hotel is located just outside Aghia Marina. If you travel by bus to Piraeus **WE HIGHLY RECOMMEND THAT YOU TAKE THIS BOAT DIRECTLY TO AGHIA MARINA**. It means that your travel time from the port of Aghia Marina to Kavos Bay is only 5 minutes! If you arrive in Aegina Town your travel time is about 30 minutes, from Souvala about 15 minutes!!! If you arrive in the port of Aghia Marina the hotel will pick you up with their free shuttle bus. NB: The Hotel is only allowed to pick you up with their shuttle bus from Aghia Marina Port. Any other arrival destination (Aegina Town and Souvala) will require a self paid taxi.

To Aegina Town (on the west side of the island).

From Piraeus there are several ferries to Aegina. There are ferries of Hellenic Seaways and Nova Ferries. There are 2 Hydrofoil companies: Hellenic Seaways and Aegean Dolphins. From AEGINA TOWN you have a 15-20 EURO taxi ride across the island to the hotel.

There are more than 20 ferries each day to Aegina from Pireaus running from 6 o'clock in the morning to 7 o'clock at night.

To Souvala (north side of the island).

There are also ferries going to Souvala, which is a cheaper and shorter trip than to Aegina Town. It takes approx 1 hour on the car ferry. From Souvala you have a 10-12 EURO taxi ride to the hotel.
